

CAPTAIN AMBIVALENT

THE ARTIST Captain Ambivalent is a satirical singer/songwriter/superhero with a sparkly gold accordion. His glacial rise from obscurity to international obscurity began at the Front Porch Music open mic in Valparaiso Indiana and has grown to include Doctor Demento, The Midnight Special, South Bend Public Television, PierogiFest, the Gen Con gaming convention, one-man shows in Fringe Festivals and alternative theaters, and even a brief cameo on America's Got Talent.

THE ALBUM "Save The Orcs" is his third album, a 10 song/18 minute EP released for Gen Con's 50th Anniversary. It features some of his geekiest material with comic takes on fantasy, horror, and sci-fi pop culture.
